**(ii) The Bus Services Bill**

This Council notes that the House of Lords recently voted to remove Clause 21 from the Bus Services Bill that is currently passing through Parliament. Clause 21 would effectively “prohibit a local authority from forming a company for the purposes of providing a local bus service”.

This Council believes that, if there is public demand in an area, then Councils or Combined Authorities should be able, if they so wish, to provide their own bus services.

Subsequently, this Council resolves to write to the Secretary of State for Transport calling on the Government not to support the readmission of Clause 21 to the Bill and to work with our colleagues across the North East Combined Authority to oppose Clause 21.
