The Masterplan will help facilitate the planning and regeneration of the Minster Quarter in line with the aspirations set out in the Central Area Urban Design Strategy and will help to achieve a much higher quality of development and influence all planning applications in the Masterplan area.

The Draft Minster Quarter Masterplan was the subject of a statutory public consultation between 15 November 2016 and 15 February 2017. Detailed comments received and how the Council considered them are presented in the Statement of Consultation.
