STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31 (6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I Julia Clare Curry authorised Agent for the National Trust for Places of Historic Interest or Natural Beauty (hereinafter referred to as 'The Trust'), North East Office, Scots Gap, Morpeth, Northumberland, NE61 4EG, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

- 1. The Trust is and has been since 1st September 1939, the owner of the land known as Penshaw Monument and since 22nd September 1982, the owner within the meaning of the above Section of the land surrounding Penshaw Monument known as Penshaw Hill, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
- 2. On the 27th day of June 2005 I deposited with The Council of The City of Sunderland, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating The Trusts property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths, the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as permissive footpaths, the way coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as a permissive bridleway and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over Trust property.
- 3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 27th June 2005 referred to in 2 above other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 24 day of Lee 2005 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
