Notice of Review of Premises Licence

Premises: The Fort, 179 Roker Avenue, Sunderland SR6 0HQ

Notice is given that on 3 July 2025 Sunderland City Council Licensing Authority received an application, given under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003, from Northumbria Police for a review of the premises licence for the above-mentioned premises on the grounds of: The Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

The Chief Constable believes the premises undermine the Licensing Objectives, in particular The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, due to the way in which the premises are being managed and operated.

It is an offence under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003 to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is level 5 on the standard scale (£5000).
