NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A MINOR VARIATION OF A
PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is given that Mitchells And Butlers Leisure Retail Ltd has applied to Sunderland City Council to vary a Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003.

The proposed variations to the Premises Licence are:

- *To add the provision of recorded music, Mondays to Sundays 10:00 – 21:00 hours, to the play area outlined in blue on the proposed layout plan. There is no change to the hours for recorded music for the existing licensed area and these remain as existing, as do the permitted hours for all other licensable activities*
- *To amend the wording of Condition 3 under Annex 2 to read:-
The premises shall operate a Challenge 21 Policy. Such policy shall be documented and kept at the premises. The policy shall be produced on request to Officers of Responsible Authorities.*

Acceptable forms of proof-of-age include:-

- *International passport;*
- *Photographic UK / EU driving licence;*
- *A PASS hologram/ultraviolet feature card,*
- *Military ID*
- *Any digital ID approved by the Government*

A record of the application may be inspected by appointment during the hours Monday to Thursday 8.30 – 5.15 and Friday 8.30 – 4.45 at the Customer Services Centre, City Hall.
