**Sunderland Core Strategy and Development Plan – Matters, Issues and
Questions**

I am now enclosing the Inspector's Matters Issues and Questions (MIQs) which will form the basis for discussion at the forthcoming hearings. The MIQs include the hearings programme which lists those who have expressed a wish to participate in each session. Please note that there has been one change from the draft programme issued alongside the Guidance Note. Matter 5 (Specific Housing Needs and Standards) will be discussed on the afternoon of Wednesday 22 May whilst Matter 4 (Housing Land Supply) will be discussed on the morning of Thursday 23 May.

These MIQs should be read in conjunction with the Guidance Note attached and while it is not my intention to summarise that document, I would like to provide a reminder regarding some of its key points:

- You have the option to respond to the Inspector's MIQs where these have relevance to your original representations;

- Where you do feel a need to submit MIQ responses, these should be with me no later than **17.00 hours on Friday 10 May** – the Guidance Note sets out content and delivery instructions.
