

Accessing advice and services on Rough Sleeping and Homelessness

 How can someone who is homeless or threatened with homelessness in the Covid 19 Crisis get advice and support?

Normally advice services would be available by the Housing Options Team at Fawcett Street, either by pre-arranged appointment or by simply turning up. Due to the Emergency Protocol introduced by the Government. Fawcett Street is now closed.


However, the service can still be accessed by phone. The Housing Options Team are available Monday to Friday 8.30am-5pm, or through our Out of Hours team, 5pm-7am 7 days a week. The contact number for both is 0191 520 5551.
