Lloyds Pharmacy Limited, Southwick Health Centre, The Green, Southwick, Sunderland, SR5 2LT
Date of closure
8 th January 2021
Impacts of the change to the PNA
Lloyds Pharmacy Ltd, Southwick - previously provided pharmaceutical access Monday – Friday and did not provide late evening opening.

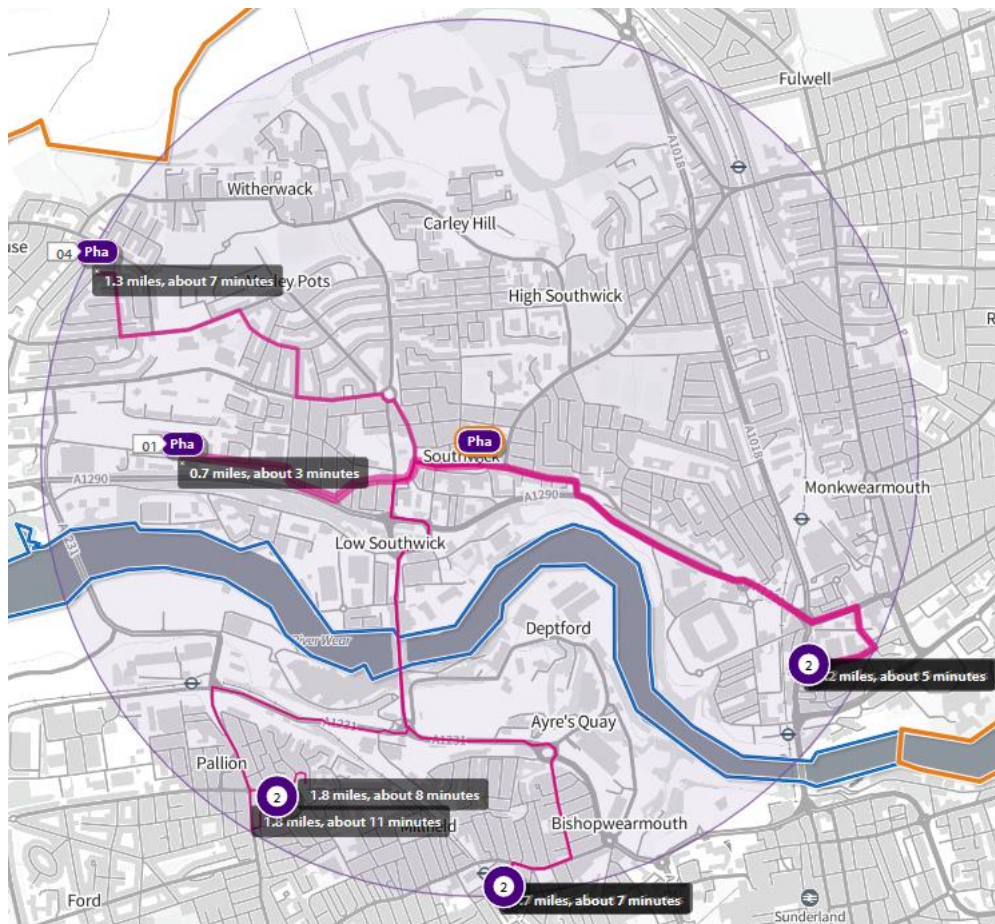


Figure 1 - Pharmacies within 1-mile radius of Lloyds Pharmacy Ltd, Southwick

Within a 1-mile radius of Lloyds Pharmacy Ltd, Southwick - there are 9 alternative pharmacies, seen in Figure 1. Within 1.3 driving route miles, there are 5 alternative pharmacies, which are:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cohens Pharmacy - Lloyds Pharmacy, Wessington Way - Well Pharmacy - Avenue Pharmacy - Redhouse Pharmacy

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Of the 5 closest pharmacies, 2 provide access on weekends, and one provides access in the evenings. (NB. A further Avenue Pharmacy, which is within a 1.1 miles radius, not listed above, is also open late evenings and weekends).

The area is well served in terms of public transport, with a frequent bus service in the area.

Consultation has occurred with key local partners around the closure, such as healthcare providers, which has been seen not to affect NHS services or access to a pharmacist.

Within the locality, there is a lack of Council commissioned services, such as smoking cessation or substance misuse recovery treatment or support, which could be met using existing contractors. However, we would like to stress that this does not affect the access to essential services that can be sought from pharmacies in the area. The creation of a new pharmacy to the area would be disproportionate in response to this issue.

Closure of this pharmacy neither creates changes to the PNA 2018-2021 that are of a significant extent to the need for pharmaceutical services in the Sunderland Health and Wellbeing Board area, nor does it create any gaps in the need for pharmaceutical services in surrounding areas.

It is deemed that a revised PNA would be a disproportionate response to the changes outlined in this Supplementary Statement.
